

With last years top 5 ranked juniors all now over the age limit a new generation of hopefuls travelled to Didcot to take part in the county junior trials. After a day involving 14 players Millennium's Michael Harrison emerged as the no 1 ranked junior in Oxfordshire.

Harrison performed consistently on the day, reeling off one victory after another to emerge as the clear winner. He will now take his place in the county side for the forthcoming season. Aged just 15 he can look forward to being a regular member of the team over the next couple of seasons.

Harrison's Millennium team mate Jack Shardlow put in an equally impressive performance. Surprising previously higher ranked opponents he finished 4th in his first appearance at these trials. Shardlow will be hoping to make his county debut at some point during the season if one of the top 3 players are unavailable.

BGN's Joe McGivern was the 3rd Banbury player to make the top 5 although he will be slightly disappointed with his 5th placed finish having started the event as one of the favourites. The Bloxham trio of William Smith, Edward Arnold & Elliott Lawrence all fought hard finishing 9th, 10th & 14th respectively.

Millennium's John Camilleri who has recently coached Harrison & Shardlow will also be appearing for the county senior side when work commitments allow.
