

Current champions Millennium A hold a slender one point lead over rivals Sibford A after 4 games in the Banbury league division 1.

Millennium started with 9-1 wins against Bodicote C & Millennium D & 8-2 victory over Millennium C where John Camilleri & Barry Hook took maximums. This was followed with a tight 6-4 win over newcomers Chacombe C despite former top 12 winner Tony Gorman taking a maximum for the visitors.

Sibford shared the spoils with the same Chacombe side. Jason Tustian won three for Sibford. Tustain has remained undefeated in the wins against all 3 Bodicote sides. Sean O'Keefe has also showed good early season form dropping just one game.

Chacombe B white washed Bodicote B. Colin Astbury & Chris Bateman took 2 each in the 6-4 win over Millennium D, for whom Rob Warnes & Jeff Ward also took 2 each. Nick Morgan's treble couldn't stop Sibford B being beaten 6-4.

Millennium C ended this unbeaten run with a 7-3 victory in a match where no player remained undefeated. Adam Jura, Peter Harris & Bartosz Pytho all took 2 for Millennium with Lewis Cox doing the same for Chacombe.

Wally Warburton has shown his usual consistent form. He took a treble to lead his Chacombe A side to a 7-3 win over newcomers Millennium C. Andy Fermor chipped in with 2 wins as did Adam Jura for Millennium.

Warburton again took all three & Fermor two as two man Chacombe beat Sibford B 6-4. Gary Edwards rejoined the side for the 9-1 mauling of Millennium D whose consolation point came courtesy of the doubles.

Chacombe & Warburton were eventually defeated when they fell to their own C team. Tony Gorman & Arun Jogi both remaining unbeaten for the C team in an impressive 8-2 victory. Jogi also took a maximum in the 6-4 win over Millennium B for whom Ashley Cox continued his good early season form taking 2, Paul Saunders did like wise.

Cox took a maximum against but couldn't stop his team falling to a 6-4 loss to Millennium C for whom Balasz Nagy & Adam Jura won two each. Cox, Paul Saunders & Paul Cox then white washed bottom side Bodicote C.

Kanan Nithi's maximum with two a piece for Dave Ewen & Charlie Sommerton saw Bodicote A emerge 8-2 winners against Bodicote B who bounced back to beat Sibford B 6-4, Gary Jackson took all three for Bodicote.
